

BATI Investigative Interview & Interrogation Training (40-Hours)

Sponsoring Agency: Montrose Police Department April 14 - 18, 2025 / 8:00 am - 5:00 pm

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Students will be introduced to a method of "Science/Evidence" based policing. Students will demonstrate the risks relying solely on human factors by evaluating three police interrogation case studies and through a series of six short exercises. Students will research assigned case studies and present their knowledge and comprehension as it relates to Miranda. Students will demonstrate their knowledge in applying these learning modules in the form of non-accusatorial interrogations with the instructor. A laptop / tablet device is encouraged for this course.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

This class is open to all sworn & civilian investigators, Parole & Probation Agents, Arson Investigators, Polygraphers, Background Investigators, Internal Affairs Investigators & Patrol Officers - If you are conducting interviews in-person, or over the phone, this class is for you! This course is a continuous curriculum for career education.

Special Instructions: This training is supported by a grant from the State of Colorado Peace Officer Standards & Training. This training is funded by POST for the West Central Training Region. For those outside this region, a wait list will be created. Any openings within 30-days, you will be notified of the availability.

Effective October 1, 2021, students must notify the sponsoring training region/provider at least 14- days prior to the training if they are not able to attend the training. If sufficient notification is not provided, your agency may be restricted from receiving future regional POST grant funding (class, scholarship, and training equipment) for a period of up to six (6) months. Any penalties issued will be at the sole discretion of the West Central Region Board.
